Accident report

This accident is recorded on the country MAC's Accident summary sheet, but no documentation of the event was on file at the MAC in January 1999.

The accident classification is inferred from the injuries.

The summary sheet recorded the device simply as an AP mine and recorded the injury as a lower leg amputation.

Compensation was awarded: US\$1,080 (36% x 30 x \$100).

Another source gave the victim's salary at \$160, which may have included a living allowance.

Analysis

The primary cause of this accident is given as a "*Field control inadequacy*" because it seems that either a mine was missed or the victim strayed into an uncleared area, both of which should have been avoided with adequate field control.
